Subject: Board of Trustees Ethics Workshop

Summary: The Board of Trustees will participate in an ethics workshop conducted by C. Christopher Anderson, General Counsel and Deputy Executive Director of the Florida Commission on Ethics. This workshop supports the Board's commitment to providing its members with on-going education and training.

C. CHRISTOPHER “CHRIS” ANDERSON, III received his J.D. from The Florida State University College of Law, after majoring in history at Huntingdon College in Montgomery, Alabama. Chris is a member of The Florida Bar and its Administrative Law Section, the Jefferson County Bar Association, the Florida Government Bar Association, and the State General Counsels' Association. He serves as General Counsel and Deputy Executive Director of the Florida Commission on Ethics, an agency he has served in a number of positions over many years. Previously, he served as an Assistant State Attorney in the Second Circuit, as an Assistant Public Defender in the Seventh and Second Circuits, as a Senior Attorney for the Department of Insurance, as an Assistant General Counsel for the Department of Corrections, and as a private practitioner. Also, Chris is a past recipient of the Florida Association of County Attorneys' Ethics Award and its Appreciation Award, he is a 2018 recipient of the Chair Service Award from the City, County, and Local Government Law Section of The Florida Bar, and he is a frequent speaker on statutory ethics and related topics at Bar CLE programs and other events.
