Repeal BOT Policy 2005-22, Tuition Reimbursement



- Seek to repeal BOT Policy 2005-22 by July 1, 2025, which currently enables full-time FAMU employees to be reimbursed for up to six credit hours from other SUS institutions.
- Spring 2025 enrollees will remain unaffected by the repeal and will receive their promised reimbursements post-internal review.
- Impacted employees are advised to explore available Tuition Waivers for courses at FAMU.
