
Amendment to the FY 2024-2025 Operating Budget-SGA Carryforward for Activity and Service Fees

Recommendation: It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the FY2024-2025 Carryforward for Activity and Service Fees.







Department Spotlight: Emergency Management

During the 2022-2023 Legislative Session, Florida A&M University was allocated \$26.9 million to address deferred maintenance and capital replacement/renewal issues and \$27.7 million to address campus-wide utility infrastructure. The following chart is an update on activities that have commenced.

- > Total Deferred Maintenance: \$22 million
- > Total Utilities Infrastructure: \$16.1 million
