## FAMU football defeats Bethune-Cookman in annual Florida Classic

As the outdoor season dawns, the Rattlers will embark on a spirited journey, beginning with consecutive in-state meets – the University of Central Florida's Black & Gold Invite on March 16 and Florida State University's FSU Relays on March 22-23.
